(St.Clairsville, OH). At the regular meeting of the Belmont County Commissioners, the Belmont County Department of Development Community Improvement Corporation (DOD/CIC) requested the county transfer the deeds of lots 14, 15, and 16 in the Fox Commerce Park (FCP) to Chuck Bell of Extreme Contracting, LLC. The St.Clairsville business is locating on 9 acres in FCP and will be constructing up to 2 buildings providing support services to the oil and gas industry.

With 10 years of experience in private and commercial construction, local businessman Bell is forming an additional company component to provide oil/gas well sound barriers, pipes and fittings, while also providing consultation services to those companies coming into the area.

Bell estimates that initially there will be 10-15 new employees hired. He is expecting to begin construction immediately.

“Working through this business plan with Mr. Bell was a positive experience and a validation of the real opportunities available to local business operators. Chuck was professional and skillful in clarifying his plan, which enabled the CIC’s administrative role in presenting this proposal to the Commissioners to be very efficient ”, said Sue Douglass, executive director of the DOD/CIC. “We all appreciate the approval of the Commissioners which strengthens their support of local business growth interacting with the influx of oil and gas business”.

FCP will now have 14 business locations in operation by the end of summer, filling nearly 100 acres of the original 125 acres.
