(St.Clairsville, OH) The Belmont County Department of Development/ Community Improvement Corporation (DOD/CIC) was present at the formal conclusion of the sale of the Martins Ferry South School building to the Belmont Senior Services, Inc. during the regular meeting of the Belmont County Commissioners. The city of Martins Ferry and the Belmont County Commission came to agreement on the purchase, with the DOD/CIC providing legal assistance for the sale. Attorney Dave Liberati acted on behalf of the county.

"Upon their request, the CIC represented the city of Martins Ferry to facilitate the sale of the former South School to the county for the Senior Services department", explained Richard Myser, CIC legal counsel. "By definition, a CIC can provide legal assistance for local government in these kinds of transactions, if requested to do so".

When the city of Martins Ferry asked for CIC assistance with this purchase, Mayor Phil Wallace presented the request to the CIC Board of Directors who composed and approved the resolution to provide the legal services.

"Usually we are the bridge between the private and the public sectors", added Sue Douglass, DOD/CIC Executive Director. "This transaction, however, illustrates one more way the CIC provides professional services to execute and expedite development within the public sector. We are glad to be of service to Martins Ferry and extend our best wishes to the Senior Services program".
